
I have just assumed this role so no prior action has been taken by me for this position.




The SRC convened on Saturday the 8th of September from 11am till 3pm for our Forward Planning Day, the following motions were passed:


#### **Actions Debrief**

- Since the previous meeting, I have prepared the Societies Council SSAF proposal with assistance from Ingrid, Gaby and Michael. I prepared additional proposals that Jenny indicated she did not support. As a result, I withdrew the aforementioned proposals.
   In addition, I advised societies executive members on re-affiliation, developed plans for Societies Council in 2015, including disciplinary procedures and the grant process, and consulted with the 2014 executive about matters concerning 2014 Societies Council awards.
- I have no reports to tender from Societies Council. Societies Council will not formally meet until 2015. At present, Ingrid is processing late grant proposals.

#### **Future Plans**

- At present, Societies Council has no ongoing events other than the 2014
   Societies Council awards. While the matters remains unresolved, it seems
   that the 2014 Societies Council awards ceremony will take place at the
   start of first semester 2015 because few students are expected to attend a
   ceremony held over the summer holidays.
- In the short run, I plan to meet with the 2015 Societies Council executive to put together a brief grant proposal guide, outlining the factors relevant to grant authorisation. In 2014, Societies Council received several spurious grant proposals that appeared to fundamentally misunderstood Societies Council's role. In addition, I plan to develop stricter disciplinary standards to ensure that grants are lodged in a timely manner and attendance at Societies Council meetings improves.

  Finally, I intend to contact society executive members early in 2015 to remind them to re-affiliate.


