NOMINATIONS INVITED

Nominations are invited from students of the University and must be lodged by email (as a scanned image) to tuu.elections@utas.edu.au so as to be received by the Returning Officer at the Tasmania University Union before 5 pm on Friday, 23 August 2019. Nomination forms are available from www.tuu.com.au/elections or the TUU Contact Centre – Sandy Bay Campus, TUU Contact Centre – Newnham Campus, Reception area – Cradle Coast Campus.

Students are advised to visit the TUU website for regional enrolment and nomination conditions for positions, as well as information for candidates. Candidates may provide a statement of up to 150 words in support of their nomination and a photo of themselves, that will be published on the TUU website, the online polling system and other means used to promote the election. Further details of requirements can be found on the nomination form.

VOTING

Polling will be conducted online from 9am on Monday 16 September to 5pm on Thursday 19 September 2019. Only students eligible to vote will receive an email at the commencement of voting, containing a link to the online polling.
