

COMMONWEALTH BANK OF AUSTRALIA UNIVERSITY SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR AWARD

Regulations as approved 6th October, 1983, 19th November, 1987, 17th November, 1988, 3rd November, 1992, 28th October, 1993, 13th October, 1994, 6th November, 2007, 6th November, 2008, 30th October 2014

1. There shall be available each year an award for outstanding individual sports achievement known as the Commonwealth Bank of Australia University Sportsperson of the Year Award.
2. The award shall be open to all students who are enrolled at the University during the year and who have sat, or whose enrolment has been accepted, for an examination conducted by the University of Tasmania.
3. For the purposes of the award, only performances recorded during the period from October 1 of the previous calendar year to September 30 of the current year shall be considered.
4. The University Sportsperson of the Year shall be selected by a Committee comprising:-
 - a) The Chairperson of the Sport and Recreation Committee, or his or her nominee, who shall be Chairman.
 - b) The President of the Tasmania University Union, or his or her nominee.
 - c) The President of the Sports Council.
 - d) One member nominated by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia.
 - e) One member nominated by the Sports Council.
 - f) One member nominated by the Blues Committee
 - g) The Secretary to the Committee will be Sports Officer, Tasmania University Union or person nominated by the TUU General Manager.
5. Nominations for the award shall be made in writing on the appropriate form and sent to the Secretary, Selection Committee, and shall specify the feats and accomplishments attained by the nominee during the year, together with whatever evidence is necessary in support of the nomination.
6. Nominations shall be called during October in each year by advertisements or publicity features placed in media outlets likely to be available to students.
7. Nominations shall close by 5.00pm on 15th October each year and shall be considered as soon as practicable by the Selection Committee. Late nominations will not be accepted without the consent of the committee.
8. Although the Selection Committee shall be the sole judge of what constitutes 'outstanding sporting achievement', it would normally regard international, national, state, regional and local feats as constituting a descending rank order or merit.
9. The winner of the University Sportsperson of the Year Award shall be presented with:-
 - A suitable trophy donated by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia at the next Annual Blues Awards Presentation and shall have his or her name inscribed on an Honour Board to commemorate the event.
 - \$1000 contributed by the Commonwealth Bank of Australia.
10. The Selection Committee reserves the right not to make an award.
11. Sportsperson of the Year Awardees are not excluded of the right to get award in another year if their nomination complies with the Regulations.
